The Secretary for Social Affairs and Culture, Dr Alexis Tam officiated at the opening ceremony of the new Macau Healthy Life Education Centre on 26 June 2016. Among the guests were representatives from official and non-governmental organisations, antidrug groups from Hong Kong and LEAP.

The new Centre comprises not only three classrooms, but also an experimental thematic room, a multifunctional theatre and a reading zone presenting anti-drug information and materials. Its aim is to spread healthy living and drug prevention messages to the people of Macau, especially children, young people and parents, through an innovative approach.

Life Education Macau holds all classes at its Centre and serves some 20,000 students annually. LEAP will continue to provide training and support to Life Education Macau as required.

Our Mission

To help prevent substance abuse, particularly drugs, including alcohol and tobacco, by providing positive health-based education programmes for young people.

Life Education originated in Australia. The first Life Education Centre was established in 1979 by the Reverend Ted Noffs in Sydney. The concept spread throughout Australia and internationally. Today Life Education also operates in Australia, Barbados, Cyprus, Finland, Hong Kong, Hungary, Macau, New

Established in 1994, Life Education Activity Programme (LEAP) is a registered charity that provides internationally recognized health awareness and drug prevention programmes for primary and secondary students. It helps students establish a healthy lifestyle and become aware of the dangers of drugs, including tobacco and alcohol. LEAP's programmes are endorsed by the Education Bureau, the Narcotics Division of the Security Bureau and the Tobacco Control Office of the

Over the last 20 years, our Primary Programme has been taken to schools in specially designed mobile classrooms, which can be driven all over the territory. LEAP also runs a Secondary Programme and a Parent Programme aimed at equipping parents with skills to help their children establish correct values and to prevent substance abuse. In the 2015/16 academic year, LEAP reached over 107,000 students, including almost 5,000 students with special needs.

Zealand, the UK and USA.

LEAP's mobile classrooms are our centre stage and make our programmes unique. They provide a relaxed environment for youngsters to enjoy the programme and become involved in discussions and role-play. Our specially trained educators make use of a modern audiovisual system, illuminated models of the human body, a "talking brain" and games. LEAP's mascots Harold the Giraffe and Holly the Horse reinforce healthy living messages by talking and singing with the children. Our aim is to provide a step-by-step approach to learning about the body and how drugs affect it. Role-play helps develop social competency skills that enable children to make responsible decisions and to say "No" to drugs without losing friends or face.

In 2014 LEAP introduced two new mobile classrooms equipped with Augmented Reality (AR) and Kinect technologies. These have now been extended to more classrooms, allowing students to enjoy an exceptional learning experience combining technology, fun and knowledge. With a fleet of nine mobile classrooms and a static centre, LEAP has attained its strategic goal of reaching 25 per cent of the primary student population.


生活教育概念源於澳洲,首間生活教育中心由 Ted Noffs 牧師於一九七九年在澳洲悉尼創辦,之後此概念傳遍澳洲,並擴展至世界各地。時至今日,生活教育已在澳洲、巴巴多斯、塞浦路斯、芬蘭、香港、匈牙利、澳門、新西蘭、英國及美國運作。

過去二十年,LEAP 以設計獨特之流動課室將生活教育課程 帶進全港各區的小學。LEAP 亦有推行中學課程以及一套家 長教育課程,以裝備家長協助子女建立正確的價值觀,抗衡 藥物的引誘。在二零一五 / 一六學年,LEAP 總共為超過十萬 七千名學生提供課程,當中包括近五千名特殊學生。

從一開始,流動課室已是 LEAP 的重要舞台,令 LEAP 的預防藥物濫用課程獨一無二。生活教育中心設計新穎獨特,為學生營造輕鬆愉快的學習環境,令他們能更投入課堂討論及角色扮演等教學活動中。受過特別訓練的教育幹事們,利用中心內的先進影音器材、會發亮的人體模型、說話的腦袋及各式互動遊戲授課。而 LEAP 的吉祥物「長頸鹿哈樂」及「小馬凱莉」更會在課程期間跟學生說等內唱歌,從而進一步鞏固健康訊息。 LEAP 透過循序漸進的教學方式,讓學生認識人體的結構及藥物對它的影響;而角色扮演更能協助學生建立社交技巧,懂得如何作出正確的抉擇,有信心地拒絕煙酒等藥物並同時保存自尊及友誼。

LEAP 於二零一四年添置了兩所增設了全新擴增實境 (AR) 和 體感 (Kinect) 科技的流動課室。為了讓更多學生能享受兼備 創新科技、樂趣與知識的非凡學習體驗,除了兩所將被取替的流動課室,其他所有課室在二零一六年中均已設置了同樣的嶄新教學科技。現時 LEAP 設有九所流動課室和一所固定教育中心,達至服務全港百分之二十五小學生的目標。

為新世代服務 Reaching out to Generation Z



從明年秋天起,參與 LEAP 小一課程的學生,將可親身見證 LEAP 吉祥物哈樂的生命探索之旅。當中,哈樂將派遣同學們喜愛的超級英雄,去尋找維持生命的要素、造成污染的原因、人類如何呼吸、及我們如何維持身體健康等的奧秘。同學們想必會樂在其中!

至於小四課程的教學影片,則會以一個科學家與他的學生們一起發明可以拯救人類的藥物為主題。課程會通過 他們的研究,去探索人體神經系統和藥物對人體的影響,



以及面對欺 凌事件時的 反應。

要為服務帶來新的轉變,我們決意為小學課程進行令人期待的更新,讓參與 LEAP 課程的學生能擁有嶄新的體驗。面對著 Z 世代的年青人,以及電子資訊時代的崛興,我們的挑戰是如何運用最佳的教育方式去吸引學生注意力,繼續貫徹 LEAP 預防青少年濫用藥物的使命。

在開始更新小學課程前,我們特別舉行了多次諮詢研討會,向本地及國際學校的老師收集意見,以助重組課程單元,希望改編的內容能貼合學生需求。以小六課程為例,我們把欺凌的主題與小四課程的壓力處理內容對調,務求更好地裝備學生,讓他們擁有正確的態度和技巧去面對不同成長階段中的挑戰。

Primary 1 students are in for a treat! From next year they will watch spellbound as Harold the Giraffe, LEAP's mascot, sends out their favourite superheroes on a mission to find out what sustains living things; what causes pollution, how humans breathe and what we can do to maintain a healthy body.

Meanwhile, in a Primary 4 video, a mysterious scientist appears, gathering a group of students to devise an amazing invention that can save the human race. As he carries out his investigations with the students, they explore the nervous system of the human body, how drugs affect it and what to do if you are bullied at school.

These are just two of the brand new ideas for theme-based programme modules which resulted from a recent brainstorming by the LEAP team. While LEAP celebrates the significant milestone of reaching over 100,000 students in the 2014/2015 academic year, it is also acutely aware that it is imperative to keep abreast of contemporary society, trends and problems.

A season of change will thus bring about the exciting renewal of LEAP's primary programme, as well as a reformation of the entire LEAP experience for students. Reaching out to Generation Z, in the new electronic information age, LEAP's challenge is to pursue our mission of preventing substance abuse among young people through educational programmes that really resonate and provoke a response with children today.

Consultation workshops with teachers from local and international schools were set up to collect invaluable feedback to help with the restructuring of LEAP's programme modules. Such information enables us to make changes that cater to the needs of the students. For example, the topic of bullying in our Primary 6 programme

我們十分感謝香港賽馬會慈善信託基金慷慨資助 LEAP 把擴增實境 (AR) 和體感 (Kinect) 科技應用到 全部課室。在教學影片的初版完成之後,教育幹事團 隊曾於幾間學校進行教學試驗,把革新的課程內容併 合新增教學科技一同應用。師生們對新課程的反應熱 烈,學生們在課堂上十分專注,一直留意主題故事的 發展。在第一輪試驗後,我們整合各參與學校的回饋 意見,再把影片和活動內容作出修訂,進一步提升課 程質素,以便於學校假期後展開第二輪試驗。

於二零一七年秋天,我們會完成六個分別為小學一至 六年級學生而設的全新小學課程。新課程在營養、生 理、藥物和酒精以及社交技巧四個方面為我們的現有 課程架構作出補充。現時 LEAP 不論在課程設計或教 學科技方面均比以往更勝一籌,我們會積極地爭取把 LEAP 的訊息傳遞到更多學校。 has now been swapped with the topic of stress in Primary 4, so that students are better equipped with the skills they need to cope with challenges at different stages of their lives.

A team of experienced LEAP educators has made every effort to brainstorm ideas for revamping our programme materials, from the themes of our year group videos, to the songs that Harold sings with the children in our mobile classrooms, and the follow-up materials for children and teachers. It was especially thrilling and rewarding for the team to see their ideas realised during the filming process and the transformation of their storyboards into real animation videos.

A theme-based programme module for each year group seems an effective approach, as the story or theme can be woven through the various elements in the programme. While in lower primary the emphasis is primarily on physiology and nutrition, the focus in upper primary is more on drug knowledge and making sure students have the skills to say "No" to drugs.

Thanks to the generous funding of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, LEAP is now using the latest AR (Augmented Reality) and Kinect technologies in our mobile classrooms. As we created our exciting new videos, the education team conducted trials of the new programme using the new technologies at several schools. Both students and teachers were excited to experience the new materials and the students were especially engaged as they followed the theme throughout the session. After these preliminary trials, feedback from schools was collected so that we can amend and improve the videos and activities further before the second round of trials, which will take place at the beginning of the autumn term.



By the autumn of 2017, LEAP will have six brand new programmes for Primary 1 to Primary 6 students. These will complement our framework in the four main areas of nutrition, physiology, drugs and alcohol, and skills. LEAP is proud that it now has better and more up-to-date resources in planning and technology than ever before, and we are keen to spread our mission to even more schools in Hong Kong!

健康兒童守護天使計劃 Healthy Angel for Kids Campaign





LEAP深信,每個兒童都值得成長為一個健康又自信的人。LEAP的使命,便是幫助學生從小建立健康的生活模式,好讓他們將來能擁有自信、豐盛的人生!但不幸地,很多兒童根本沒有機會學習建立健康及充實人生所需要的知識和技能。為了讓每位兒童都有一個健康的起步點,LEAP推出了健康兒童守護天使計劃。

LEAP 目前每年為全港約八萬名小學生提供預防藥物濫用課程,約佔全港小學生人數的百分之二十五,但目前仍有百分之七十五的小學生尚未受惠。基於家庭資源限制,很多居於偏遠新市鎮的兒童欠缺參加課外活動的機會,令他們缺乏社交支援及變得沒有自信。另外,亦有部分學校是由於空間限制,未能容納 LEAP 的流動課室於校內停泊,錯過讓學生學習健康生活模式的機會。由於資源和地理上的規限,居於偏遠地區的兒童及青少年更容易受到毒品等不良誘惑的影響。

Our aim is to help young people to build a healthy, drug-free lifestyle so that they may become fulfilled individuals who contribute to society. Unfortunately, many children do not have access to the knowledge and skills to make this dream come true. That is why LEAP has launched the "Healthy Angel for Kids Campaign" to ensure every child gets a healthy start.

LEAP currently delivers its drug prevention programmes to over 80,000 primary students - around 25% of the primary school population – every year. However, 75% of students are still to benefit from LEAP's messages. Due to family circumstances, children living in remote areas may not have the opportunity to take part in extra-curricular activities that are so important in building a social support network and developing self-confidence. There are also schools that simply cannot accommodate LEAP's mobile classroom on their premises. Lack of resources and geographical restrictions make young people in remote parts of the city more susceptible to drug use.

To help protect this group of children, the Hong Kong Racehorse Owners Association Charitable Foundation has kindly pledged to donate HK\$50,000 in support of the Healthy Angel for Kids Campaign. The sponsorship will

enable 500 students studying in village schools to benefit from LEAP's drug prevention programmes which will have a positive impact on children for the rest of the lives. LEAP is most grateful to the Foundation for its continuous generosity in supporting the promotion of healthy living among children in Hong Kong.

生活教育跨校園計劃(第二期) LEAP without Boundaries II



LEAP 欣喜地宣布,第二期的生活教育跨校園計劃即將展開,我們再次衷心感謝利希慎基金及周大福慈善基金的慷慨捐助。

LEAP is excited to announce the launch of the second phase of the "LEAP without Boundaries" project, thanks again to the generosity of Lee Hysan Foundation and Chow Tai Fook Charity Foundation.

As in the first phase of the project, each Foundation will give an annual donation of HK\$427,500, enabling

4,500 students from six primary schools to enjoy LEAP's drug prevention programme free of charge for six years from September 2016. In addition, 200 parents of students from these schools will be offered LEAP's highly pragmatic parent programme to enhance support for their children.

Once again, the six schools which will benefit from "LEAP without Boundaries II" are being selected under stringent criteria. As well as showing a keen interest in LEAP's programmes, each school must have a strong commitment to work with LEAP for six consecutive years.

In May 2016, Mr Peter Cheng, Chairman of Chow Tai Fook Charity Foundation and Ms Leonie Ki, Governor of the Foundation each visited a LEAP mobile classroom. Mr Clifford Chow, Assistant Vice President of Lee Hysan Foundation also interviewed three potential schools to benefit from its funding.

生活教育 Cheer 獎學金烹飪比賽 Cheer for LEAP Scholarship Cooking Contest



「生活教育 Cheer 獎學金」二零一五 / 一六最後一輪的烹飪比賽及頒獎儀式,已於二零一六年八月二十一日順利舉行,賽程緊張又刺激。

該獎學金由 LEAP 主辦,承蒙大昌行集團有限公司 慷慨捐助,目的是鼓勵本地小學生建立健康的飲 食及生活模式,並增進親子關係。今年計劃吸引 近六十名小學生參加。於第一階段初選,申請學生 需與一名家長或監護人一起以「食得健康又滋味! Cheer!」為創作主題,為家人設計一道新穎健康的 菜式,並提交食譜。經過初選後,十二隊入圍隊伍 (初小組六隊、高小組六隊)獲邀出席最後一輪的 烹飪比賽,即場烹調自創健康食譜,由評判團選出 優勝者。

在烹飪比賽中,各參賽隊伍都充分展現他們精湛的 廚藝和良好的親子溝通。雖然每隊只有一小時準備 食材及烹調,但他們預備的菜式不但醒胃又健康, 而且非常美味。最後評判團根據食材選擇及配搭、

營養價值、烹調/製作方法(是否簡便、 健康)及創意四個範疇選出優勝者,比 賽在充滿歡樂的氣氛下圓滿結束。

There was great excitement on 21 August 2016 when the final round of the Cheer for LEAP Scholarship Cooking Contest was held, followed by an award presentation.

Cheer for LEAP Scholarships are run by LEAP with funding from Dah Chong Hong Holdings to encourage Hong Kong primary students to pursue a healthy diet and lifestyle and to promote parentchild relationships. This year the scheme attracted nearly 60 primary students. In the first round, students were asked to partner with a parent or guardian to create a family-friendly healthy recipe. After a preliminary assessment, 12 teams (6 from

the Lower Primary category, 6 from the Upper Primary category) were selected to prepare their dish on site for final judging.

During the final cooking contest, the participating teams fully demonstrated their outstanding cooking skills and effective parent-child communications. Although they were given just one hour to prepare and cook, their dishes not only looked appetizing and healthy but also tasted delicious! 
